The Congregation for the Causes of Saints promulgated on June 19, 2020, the decree with the authorization of Pope Francis for the beatification of Venerable Dr. Jose Gregorio Hernandez. The news filled Venezuela with joy. Jose Gregorio Hernandez was a Venezuelan doctor with a deep religious vocation, a Catholic recognized for his solidarity with those most in need.

Before this important acknowledgment, on June 2, 2020, the leader of the Betania Choir, Professor Maria Auxiliadora Bianchini Leon, made the announcement of the musical work she had carried out with the Betania Choir, on the occasion of honoring Venerable Doctor Jose Gregorio Hernandez, on the eve of his beatification. The lyrics and music are by Johnatan Garcia, and the arrangements by the same composer and Henry Villalobos.

### Communities of Betania United in Prayer for 91 Days



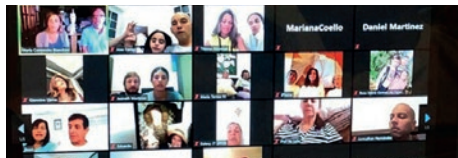
Prayer before the Blessed Sacrament

Within these days of prayer, it is worth noting the I, II, III, IV, V and VI Worldwide Betania Prayer Event held every Sunday of May, with Fr. Timothy Byerley, Fr. Cadmus Mazzarella and Fr. Juan Carlos Silva as special guests. Likewise, the Holy Hour to the Blessed Sacrament was recited every Thursday, by means of the same technological modality.

## Reflections of the Servant of God Maria Esperanza Bianchini

Speech of the Servant of God Maria Esperanza Bianchini  
Mayfield Inn Trade Center, Edmonton, Alberta, Canada  
Sunday, May 24, 1998



We are the People of God, we are life of God, we are an organization of God. He is who orders us. He is who commands us. Sometimes we believe, "I'm going to do this, I'm going to do that." No, no, children, do not fight in vain; yes, yes we are going to do things, but do not believe that we are talented that we can do everything, no.

Humility, serenity, rest, calm, comprehending the gift of understanding to truly understand what God wants from each one of us. We should not to say: "I do, I do that because I can." No, in a moment we can lose our lives, in a moment we can have an incurable disease; so many things can happen... an accident. We must live according to the will of God, in the arms of Mary our Heavenly Mother.

## SPIRITUAL MAXIMS OF THE SERVANT OF GOD MARIA ESPERANZA BIANCHINI

- God lives in each one of us. This is his great moment of calling mankind, for his Mother is leading the ship as Queen of the World.
- The time for social communities, spiritual communities will come.
- When spiritual and scientific matters unite, there will no longer be diseases in the world.

## CHRONOLOGICAL DATA ON MARIA ESPERANZA

- On September 2, 1990, the Bianchini-Medrano traveled to Sardinia, Italy. There, the Servant of God had a vision of the Virgin, who announced that war would be waged. This took place on January 16, 1991, when the war between the United States and Iraq began.
- On January 21, 1991, the Servant of God Maria Esperanza went to Finca Betania, accompanied by relatives and members of the Betania Foundation, to spend a night vigil of prayer. At dawn, at 2:00 a.m., those present saw the image of Jesus, Christ the King.

We have fallen into another trap of the devil; the trap of thinking that holiness is reserved only for those who have the ability to achieve great deeds, such as, for example, Saint Leo the Great, year 461, a Pontiff who had to fight against great heresies; or Saint Charles of Borromeo, year 1538, who founded seven hundred catechism schools, six seminaries and did many more works, just to name two examples.

Saint Anonymous are the priests, doctors, nurses, volunteers, who have laid down their lives in this coronavirus crisis. This saint is the self-sacrificing and loving housewife, who makes her home a temple of the Holy Spirit for her husband and children, who holds her family together with the bond of prayer. This saint is the father of a family who, in addition to working hard for their daily bread, strives to make his wife and children happy and to be an example of Christian virtue. We can all be Saint Anonymous and in fact we all have this call. Those that God has allowed to leave anonymity aside is because they need to be a reference for the world, but those that He leaves anonymous is so that they give support to the basis of his Church. All the great saints aspired anonymity. No saint wanted to be recognized as such, but as the Holy Scriptures clearly express, specifically Luke (14:11) "For everyone who raises himself up will be humbled, and the one who humbles himself will be raised up". They humbled themselves before God and He led them to the altars. Let us sanctify ourselves day by day, without the anxiety of great things, but focusing on small deeds, which in the eyes of God are great, and He who sees all that is done in secret will secretly reward us (cf.
