## Reflections of the Servant of God Maria Esperanza Bianchini

Speech of the Servant of God Maria Esperanza Bianchini  
Tampa, Florida, USA  
Saturday, February 26, 1994



O People of God, blessed People who come seeking the Lord. Forge ahead, do not hesitate! Come, everyone! For everyone has the right to enter into the house of the Holy Father the Pope. It is the house of each and every one, where we can prepare ourselves to live the Gospel. These times require evangelization, to go after our brothers, after small innocent children, and after the poor who many times do not have a piece of bread to bring to their mouth.

So many innocent ones go astray! So many souls are suffering every day from spiritual unbalance in their souls, because society is contaminating itself with a variety of unpleasant things for the heart of the children of God, of those who feel their God, of those who love their God, and follow the rules of the great doctrine that Jesus bequeathed us.

Brothers, respectable priests, the life of a priest is so beautiful. Lord, it is so great. There is no time to rest: The Eucharist and constant meditation with their rosary in their hand from daybreak on.

## Spiritual Maxims of the Servant of God Maria Esperanza Bianchini

- Let us turn our hearts to the Sacred Heart of Jesus and the Immaculate Heart of Mary. The two Hearts who gave themselves and definitively surrendered to give their lives for the salvation of the world with love, humility and patience. They gave it all for us and continue to do so every day, in the celebration of Holy Mass and on all the altars of the world.
- He who places his trust in the Sacred Heart of Jesus will receive graces, peace and love.

## Chronological Data on Maria Esperanza

- In 1992, the books "Apparitions in Betania, Venezuela" written by Sister Margaret Sims from the US and "The Final Hour" written by Michael Brown, were published. Both have information on Betania and the Servant of God Maria Esperanza.
- On February 1, 1992, a night vigil for the day of Our Lady of the Candles took place at the Betania Sanctuary. The Bianchinis attended a Mass officiated by Bishop Pio Bello Ricardo and stayed for three days at Finca Betania, accompanied by members of the Betania Foundation.

### Pope Francis Invites Us to Prayer and Closeness
